Parramatta Light Rail Stage 2

In October 2017, the NSW Government announced the preferred route for Parramatta Light Rail Stage 2, which will connect to Stage 1 and run north of the Parramatta River through the rapidly developing suburbs of Ermington, Melrose Park and Wentworth Point to Sydney Olympic Park, providing a new public transport option to the booming sport, entertainment and employment hub.

An option for extending east through Camellia before crossing the Parramatta River to Rydalmere is also being considered. Stage 2 will be further developed through consultation with the community and stakeholders.

Essential geotechnical investigation work is being undertaken to assist with early planning and design work for Stage 2 Parramatta Light Rail.

This work is required to help determine underlying soil and rock conditions.

Geotechnical investigations

Investigation work will occur in **Camellia, Rydalmere, Ermington, Melrose Park, Wentworth Point and Sydney Olympic Park** (please see map overleaf) between **July and August 2019**, weather and site conditions permitting.

Any sites anticipated to require night works are marked in red on the map overleaf.

Work will include:

- Establishing a temporary work area
- Using a vacuum excavation truck to ensure the drilling location is clear of services
- Using a truck or track mounted drill rig to bore below ground level

What to expect:

- Noise impact from these activities is expected to be minimal
- Traffic control and directional signage will be in place for the safety of workers and the community
- Access to pathways, buildings and driveways will be maintained at all times.

Hours of work

Most of the work will be undertaken during standard construction hours which are **7am to 6pm Monday to Friday, and 8am to 1pm on Saturday.**

Access to businesses will be maintained during operating hours, and access to driveways will be maintained at all times. Please follow the direction of traffic controllers, directional signs and proceed carefully.
